PowerSchool & AKCIS Integration

The following school districts are enjoying increased ease of access to AKCIS due to single sign-on through student's PowerSchool accounts. Teachers/counselors in PowerSchool districts no longer need to look up students' AKCIS usernames and passwords. AKCIS Staff Account holders are also able to use the single sign-on capabilities to access through PowerSchool to their AKCIS Staff Accounts. Optional Products

SIS Integration – Available FREE to PowerSchool school districts in Alaska. In Phase I of this enhancement students can use single sign-on through their PowerSchool IDs to log into their AKCIS portfolio and staff account holders can use single sign-on with the AKCIS icon in PowerSchool to log into their AKCIS Staff Accounts. PLCP (PLP) Premium – Available **FREE** to all high school, college, and adult site types.

This enhancement extends the standard functionality by providing advanced customization, online editing, and reporting options.. Students can complete the PLCP with this quick navigation. Site Administrators can include the district's Graduation Requirements alongside the Alaska Performance Scholarship Requirements. This add-in can be purchased and activated for any active AKCIS site account. Upon activation, PLP Premium is fully integrated with AKCIS and users from that location can begin using the enhanced features of the PLCP document. **Note: PLCP (PLP) Premium is being provided to Alaska Statewide Schools and Organizations by the Department of Education & Early Development, Division of Career & Technical Education.
