

## FY2015 Statewide Partner Activities in Support of the Alaska Career and Technical Education Plan

### Strategy 1 - Make transitions planned and accountable

- Presented PLCP information at Alaska ACTE fall and PTA conferences, and to DOLWD CTE grantees
- Coordinated and delivered AKCIS training for the second time at UAF, the first time at UAA and UAS and for UA Transition Coalition (Tech Prep/Career Pathways Coordinators)
- PLCP resources incorporated into UAF Advising and Counseling E-Learning Certificate
- PLCP parent engagement brochure drafted and being vetted with parents for feedback to then finalize
- Career Pathways folders updated and distributed to school districts

### Strategy 2 - Align CTE curricula at all training institutions with industry standards

- Distributed survey on CTE common definitions; based on results the definitions are being incorporated into EED's state plan
- Developed crosswalk of CTE Plan with other Alaska workforce development plans and posted website
- Participated in cross-agency and industry planning meeting to identify commonalities for collaboration in implementing the CTE Plan and workforce development plans

### Strategy 3 - Identify and promote effective CTE delivery

- Posted sample evaluation instruments to CTE Plan website
- EED delivered an exemplar program training at the spring CTE Worksession
- Featured Alaska ACTE award winners in CTE Plan Quarterly Newsletter to promote CTE success

### Strategy 4 - Develop and support CTE staff

- Reviewed UAA CTE professional development needs survey, UA teacher gap report and EED Type M CTE certification data; identified CTE was not included in gap report, connected with CAEPR to suggest including it
- EED funded Future Educators of Alaska for 3<sup>rd</sup> year and met with district coordinators last fall
- Met with EED Teacher Certification Administrator to review new forms and requirements for the Type M CTE Limited Certificate; posted new information/forms to website and distributed through CTE coordinator listserv
- Developing plan to create a CTE curriculum repository and index of articulation agreements

### Strategy 5 - Maximize the use of public facilities for training

- Posted example facilities use agreements as templates on website

### Strategy 6 - Establish and maintain sustainable funding

- Legislature continued 1.5% factor to K-12 foundation funding for CTE
- EED's Perkins' CTE grants continued for secondary, postsecondary and NTO as well as partnership projects
- DOLWD CTE Grant Funding - \$625,000 in FY12, FY13, FY14, and FY15
- Technical Vocational Education Program (TVEP) funding increased by \$895,000 for FY16 to total \$12.5 million

### CTE Plan Communication

- Revised EED, DOLWD and UA websites to provide unduplicated information
- Developed and maintained CTE Plan website
- Developed and implemented plan to provide quarterly updates to stakeholders, including a scorecard to update progress on action items
- Provided CTE updates to EED and DOLWD Commissioners, and UA President; continued to receive their support
- Presented updates to stakeholders on implementation efforts at the Alaska ACTE PDC, Alaska School Board Association, spring CTE Worksession and UA Community Campus Directors' meetings
- Provided a one-page handout to update Superintendents at their fall meeting
- Posted previous Action Committee meeting documents to website
